



College Bound Commitment for Washington State Students!

Are you interested in health care? Construction? Video game design? Running a business? No matter your career dreams, College Bound can help you get to and pay for the school that is right for you!

Who is eligible for College Bound?

If you get free and reduced-price lunch in 7th, 8th, or just became eligible in 9th grade, you are automatically enrolled in College Bound.

What is College Bound?

- College Bound is an early commitment of state financial aid, like the Washington College Grant, to help pay for college and technical school.
- Students who meet the program requirements receive the average cost of tuition (at public college rates), some fees, and a small amount for books.
- There are 65+ colleges, universities, and technical schools in Washington for students who meet the [eligibility requirements](#) when they graduate high school.

What are the College Bound requirements?

- You must graduate with a cumulative 2.0 GPA or higher if you plan to attend a four-year public or private college directly after high school.
 - **Starting fall 2023:** No high school GPA requirement if you plan to attend a community college or technical school! Please confirm with our school if our district requires a certain GPA to graduate.
- Have no felony convictions, and
- Meet income requirements each year in college or training when you apply for financial aid starting your senior year in high school.
