Some colleges will be participating in a vaccine incentive program, which may include awarding scholarships to student(s). WSAC guidance below covers the treatment of any vaccine scholarship with state financial aid awarding. This does not include federal aid.

**Exclusion of Washington Vaccine Incentive Scholarship**

Any Washington Vaccine Incentive Scholarship awarded to a student does NOT need to be included in any financial need calculation when awarding state financial aid. This would mean that any distribution of this scholarship would not result in a state financial aid over-award.

For questions about the vaccine incentive program, we encourage you to contact those on your campus that are reviewing or signed the interagency agreement. For community and technical colleges, you will also be receiving information from SBCTC.
