<b>Synopsis</b>	<p>Council committees (Committee on Funding and Affordability; Committee on Student Support; Committee on Academic Affairs and Policy) have not been scheduled for 2016 to allow time for legislative activities. The proposed 2016 Council Committee overall work plan will be to develop Strategic Action Plan recommendations.</p> <p>With the Council’s approval, the meetings will be scheduled for the alternating months of the Council meetings. When there is overlap of focus, CAAP and CSS will be merged.</p> <p>The CSS committee will be developing possible recommendations related to adult-reengagement strategies and supporting underrepresented students, following the Roadmap Progress Report data findings.</p> <p>The CAAP committee will be reviewing dual credit, transfer issues, and a regional analysis of postsecondary opportunities.</p> <p>The CFA committee will be finalizing the Framework, continuing the discussion of affordability “thresholds,” and developing the budget proposals related to the strategic action plan for prioritization by the Council.</p>
