**Background:**

Founded in 2004, Evergreen Beauty College (EBC) – Everett/Renton trains students for careers in cosmetology, esthetics and master esthetics, hair design, manicuring, therapeutic massage (Everett campus only) and cosmetology instruction. The school is licensed by the Washington Department of Licensing’s Business and Professions Division – Cosmetology Section.

EBC – Everett/Renton is nationally accredited by the National Accrediting Commission of Cosmetology Arts and Science (NACCAS) and is fully certified for participation in federal Title IV programs, including the Pell Grant and Direct Loan programs.

**Nature of the review:**

The Washington Student Achievement Council (WSAC) evaluates the applicant’s accreditation status; participation status in federal Title IV programs; financial aid staff qualifications; fiscal operations and systems; facilities; compliance audits and federal program reviews; financial aid policies and procedures; and historical financial strength, enrollment, cohort default rate performance, and student completion and placement outcomes.

The initial review of EBC – Everett/Renton’s application materials indicates the institution meets the requirements for provisional participation in state financial aid programs. The next step in the process is an institutional site visit and evaluation, anticipated to occur in November 2017.

**Timeline:**

The WSAC will accept comments on this application until October 20, 2017.
