



Hello FAA Colleagues!

We hope this email finds you well.

As we have navigated the process of verifying high school information in the Checker together, we wanted to provide some decision-making guidance for students who do not submit their high school transcript after it has been requested.

If an institution is unable to verify high school information by May 1st of a given academic year, they may override the HS Grad Year to the following: "Transcript requested, but not received" in the CBS Eligibility Checker. In the "Reason" box, please indicate how and when the student was contacted.

Doing so will allow the student to receive WA Bridge grant for the year and in future years. If a student does turn in a transcript, the institution must update the CBS Eligibility Checker. If the student is CBS eligible, the student must be awarded CBS for that academic year.
