Definitions

Content: The textual, visual, or aural content that is encountered as part of the user experience on websites. It may include—among other things—text, images, sounds, videos, and animations.

Possible methods for delivering content on this website:

- **Tailoring:** Specific information delivered to users as a result of users' prompted answers to site-based questions.
- Interactivity: Information delivery through users' interaction with widgets (e.g. sliders, checkboxes, sortable tables, etc.).
- Static content: Information delivered through site navigation that is unchanged by user inputs.
- **Functions:** Administrative tasks (both performed by authorized users and automated) to generate reports and site analytics, download information, or supplement content.
