Tier I includes all PhD students and masters' degrees not specified below.

Tier II includes Education, Forest Resources, Non-professional School of Medicine, and Master of Marine Affairs [GTTL], and Master of Marine Affairs, Bothell and Tacoma Masters in Nursing, and Bothell Master of Arts in Policy Studies.

Tier III includes Real Estate, Construction Management, Engineering, Nursing, Public Health and Computing and Software Systems (Tacoma only), Engineering masters and PhD, Master of Nursing Science and PhD.

WSU Notes:

In Pullman only, additional fees include Student Recreation Center, Health, Transit, and CUB fee which total \$839 for all groups. Resident and nonresident undergraduates also pay an additional \$50 for the stadium for a total of \$889. **In Spokane only**, the mandatory health fee is \$156.

Master of Business Administration rate is for only the Pullman campus. Students enrolled in the MBA programs at WSU Tri-Cities and WSU Vancouver, as well as students completing the legacy MBA program in Pullman, will continue to pay the regular graduate student tuition rate.

Students **continually enrolled in the Masters of Nursing program** since 2004-05 academic year pay a lower transitional rate as they complete their programs. In 2008-09 these amounts increase to \$10,700 for resident students and \$24,364 for non-resident students.

WWAMI. Under a memorandum of understanding (MOU) between WSU and UW, students attending the first year of medical school in Seattle, Pullman, or Spokane will pay the same total tuition and enrollment fees. These rates are set by the University of Washington for the medical school. Other mandatory fees are assessed based on the specific campus where the student is enrolled.

General & Institution Specific Notes:

Tuition and fee rates reflect those reported by institutions.

Services and Activities Fee: S&A fees can increase by a percentage not to exceed the annual percent increase in respective tuition category; this increased rate did not apply to the amount committed to repayment of bonded debt.

TESC additional mandatory fees for 2009-10 include health and counseling fees, a bus pass fee, clean energy fee, and CAB building fee. The fees are standard across all categories and total \$547 per year.

WWU additional mandatory fees include a health service fee, non-academic building fee, renewable energy fee levied on a per credit basis to a maximum of 10 credit hours per quarter, a student recreation fee and a transportation fee. These fees are standard across all categories and total \$687 per year.

Community college tuition and fee rates are based on 15 credit hours per quarter for 3 quarters. The tuition figure above reflects the maximum S&A fee. Other fees, including technology fees vary by school.
