What is the PSLF Program?

- Federal debt relief program overseen by U.S.
 Department of Education's Office of Federal Student Aid (FSA)
- Forgives balance on federal student loans after
 10 years of public service employment <u>while</u> making qualifying payments









How does PSLF work?



To qualify for PSLF you need these 4 things.

- 1. Right type of employment
 - a) Government
 - b) Non-profit (501(c)(3), other with qualifying services
- 2. Right type of loan
- 3. Right type of repayment plan
- 4. Right number of payments



Qualifying employment



Full time

Directly employed with public employer (W2)

Average of 30+ hours/week

Multiple part-time public service jobs = 30 hours+/week avg

Contractors <u>only</u> if job is prohibited by state law to be provided by direct employees

Public employer(s)

Any level of government

501c3 nonprofit organizations

Employer more important than role

Must be employed when you apply

Nonprofit with other tax status

Military service
Public health services
Public education

Public library services Early childhood ed.

Public interest law Disability services

No labor unions or partisan political orgs




PSLF often overlooked by Employers

Recruitment & Retention Benefits



Benefits received for very little effort or cost:

- Enhance recruitment efforts
 - Increase candidate pools.
 - Attract candidates with education-related job competencies.
- Improve employee retention
 - 10-year employment goal.
 - Improve employee engagement and work-life balance.

PSLF Employer Best Practices



- Designate a PSLF point-of-contact & certify employment.
- 2 Share PSLF information with your employees on a regular basis.
- Post PSLF contact information on internal and external websites.
- Advertise that you are a PSLF-qualifying employer.



Designate a PSLF point-of-contact & certify employment.









PSLF Authorized Contact Official





Designate someone to complete PSLF employment certification forms.

- "Authorized contact official" = anyone in your organization who has access and is authorized to review employment information about your employees.
- You can appoint one or more staff members to serve in this role.





PSLF Contact Email Address



Designate an email address for submission of PSLF employment certification forms.

- We recommend using a general email address (for example, your main HR email) to avoid confusion and delays due to staff changes.
- Your designated "authorized official(s)" need access to this email.





Employment Certification Process



Employees may submit PSLF Forms for employers to certify employment in two ways:

- Manually using a PDF or paper form.
- Digitally using the PSLF Help Tool available on <u>StudentAid.gov/pslf</u> (preferred).

PSLF Help Tool Process:



1. Employees use PSLF Help Tool to generate PSLF Form



2. Employees submit PSLF Form to organization's PSLF contact



3. Employers sign employment certification portion of PSLF Form via DocuSign



4. FSA's system automatically processes the form



Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) Employer Search

To determine if your employer qualifies for PSLF, enter their Employer Identification Number (EIN) and your employment dates below.

Please note that many state and local governments use a shared EIN to pay their employees, so you should rely on the appropriate result if one displays. Likewise, many federal agencies share EINs, so you may need to filter by keyword or click through multiple pages to find your employer.

PSLF Employer Search Status



Confirm the status of your Employer Identification Number (EIN) in the <u>PSLF Employer Search Database</u>.

- "Eligible" = PSLF forms will be processed automatically by Federal Student Aid.
- "Ineligible", "undetermined" or "not found" = employees will need to submit supporting documentation with their PSLF Form:
 - W-2 statement.
 - The state or local statutes that establishes you as a governmental organization.
 - Documentation of your organization's FEIN/EIN.
- Once form is approved, FSA will change your organization's status to "eligible."



Share PSLF Information on a Regular Basis









Suggested PSLF Notices



Student Loan Advocate PSLF Notice Templates:

- PSLF Annual Notice send information to all employees on an annual basis and any time PSLF regulations change to continue raising awareness of the program.
- Recertification reminder send a reminder one year following the date the last employment certification was completed.
- PSLF Notice for New Employees send a notice as part of your onboarding process to introduce the PSLF program and process.
- **PSLF Notice for Separated Employees** send a notice when employees leave your organization.



Borrowers may submit a complaint and/or question about their student loans to the Office of the Student Loan Advocate.

Borrowers can ask a question about:

- 1. Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF).
- 2. Income-driven repayment (IDR) plans.
- 3. Delinquency and default.
- 4. Deferment and forbearance.
- 5. Loan forgiveness and discharges.
- 6. Consolidation.
- 7. Other student loan questions.
