Subject: SAI Formula A Miscalculation for WASFA Filers

Good afternoon!

We want to inform the community that, thanks to feedback from schools, we discovered an issue with the SAI Formula A calculation for 2025-26 WASFA filers.

For 2024-25, the [SAI calculation](#) for Student Available Income adjusted the SAI calculation by up to -1,500 for students with available incomes of -1,500 or lower.

30. Student's Contribution from Income (line 28 times line 29)

- If negative and $< -1,500$, adjust to $-1,500$ (e.g., if $-2,000$ set to $-1,500$)
- If negative and $\geq -1,500$, do not adjust (e.g., if $-1,000$ leave as $-1,000$)

However, this same part of the calculation is not present for 2025-26. Upon identifying this issue, we submitted a ticket to our application vendor, who expects to resolve it by mid-April through a recalculation of SAIs.

Since state financial aid eligibility is based on income and family size, this issue should not affect awarded funds for 2025-26, however, once the correction is deployed, we encourage you to make sure you check for over awards.
