Background:

The Washington College Grant (WCG) was created in 2019-20, to provide a statewide free college program for eligible participants, and greater access to postsecondary education for Washington residents. The Washington College Grant was expanded to include approved apprenticeship programs under Chapter 49.04 RCW, which started in the 2020-21 fiscal year. The program is also referred to as WA Grant for Apprenticeship (WG-A).
