Project BioPath: Current Pilot

- 5 month program for HS credit (Feb. to June)
- Extension of HS Biotechnology Pathway
- 6 paid internship positions for students who are 18 years old
- Interns train in three departments
 - Process Development
 - Quality Assurance
 - Manufacturing

Project BioPath: 2019-20...

- Full-year program for HS credit (Oct. to June)
- 18 paid internship positions for students ages 16 to 18
- Planning toward Youth Apprenticeship Program
 - AGC Training Center
 - Curriculum Development
 - Dual Credit and Industry Certification/Credential
- Full Launch of onsite Youth Apprenticeship Training Program in fall 2020-21
