Program	For who?	Details & steps
Pipeline for Paraeducators Conditional Scholarship	Community & technical college students	Supports paraeducators and Recruiting Washington Teachers alumni who wish to become teachers by funding an Associate degree. Up to \$4,000 per year. Apply at portal.wsac.wa.gov/a/teacher-shortage
Teacher Shortage Conditional Scholarship	Graduate & undergraduate students	Designed to encourage persons to become teachers and retain these teachers in shortage areas. Up to \$8,000 per year. Apply at portal.wsac.wa.gov/a/teacher-shortage
Alternative Routes Conditional Scholarship	Undergraduate students	For students in an Alternative Route teacher certification program and intend to pursue a certificate in a shortage area. Up to \$8,000 per year. Apply at schools with PESB block grants.
Student Teaching Grant	Graduate & undergraduate students	A grant for students enrolled in a PESB-approved teacher prep program, and student teaching in a Public Title 1 School in Washington. Apply at portal.wsac.wa.gov/a/teacher-shortage
Educator Retooling Conditional Scholarship	Current educators	Helps current educators that hold a residency or professional WA teacher certificate issued after 2005 (or are continuing an expired one). Apply at portal.wsac.wa.gov/a/teacher-shortage
