



Registering for a Statewide Vendor Number (SWVN) through Office of Financial Management (OFM)

The Washington Student Achievement Council (WSAC) processes payments through the Office of Financial Management (OFM). As a WA Grant for Apprenticeship (WG-A) recipient, you must have a Statewide Vendor Number (SWVN) with OFM for WSAC to send you WG-A award payment.

WSAC is unable to send your award payment without a SWVN.

To obtain a SWVN:

1. Go to: <u>Statewide Vendor/Payee Services | Office of Financial Management (https://ofm.wa.gov/it-systems/accounting-systems/statewide-vendorpayee-services</u>).

You should complete the DocuSign option (completing the PDF option may take longer).

You must complete both the registration and the direct deposit form.

2. Select the form: Vendor/Payee Registration Web Form

If you already have a SWVN for an IRS reporting type other than Individual/Sole Proprietor (e.g., for your business), you will need to register for an individual SWVN.

If you already have a SWVN with OFM as an Individual/Sole Proprietor, use the **Vendor/Payee Change Form** to update information (if needed). Once updates are submitted (or if no updates are needed), skip to Step #4.

3. Complete the form as directed.

*Note: For "Tax Type based on your IRS reporting status," use "Individual/Sole Proprietor." (See Figure 1 or Figure 2 on page 2)

4. Select and complete the Direct *Deposit Authorization* form.

You should select Direct Deposit for faster processing. A paper check payment may add 2 to 4 weeks processing and delivery time. Please ensure all banking information is accurate.

- 5. You will receive an email from OFM with your SWVN. Please save this email for your records.
- 6. Provide your SWVN to us using the *Payment Information* box on your landing page in the <u>WG-A</u> <u>Funding Application Portal</u>. (See Figure 4 on page 3)

Help with OFM SWVN

OFM has provided instruction videos to help with completing these three forms. These videos are on the <u>Statewide Vendor/Payee Services</u> page on the right side in a box labeled *Training*.
