Learning outcomes	Chapter 1 discussion questions
<p>After watching chapter 1, students will know...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How they are signed up</li> <li>• CB is a state financial aid program for education after high school, covering average tuition (at public college rates), some fees, and a small amount for books</li> <li>• CB can be used at over 65 schools in WA</li> <li>• That school and WSAC staff can help students and their families prepare for college</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What is the CB program, and how does it help students?</li> <li>• How do students get signed up for CB?</li> <li>• Who can you contact if you have questions?</li> <li>• Bonus activity: check out the list of participating institutions at <a href="http://wsac.wa.gov/sfa-institutions">wsac.wa.gov/sfa-institutions</a></li> </ul>

### Chapter 2: What are the requirements of College Bound?

<p>After watching chapter 2, students will know...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The CB pledge requirements</li> <li>• They must meet income requirements and apply for financial aid during senior year and each year in college</li> <li>• Must enroll in college or career training within one year of high school graduation</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What are the requirements to use CB funds?</li> <li>• Why do students need to apply for financial aid?</li> <li>• When is the college enrollment deadline?</li> </ul>

### Chapter 3: How Much is the College Bound Commitment?

<p>After watching chapter 3, students will know...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maximum amount (mostly met with WA Grant funds) that students can receive with the CB Commitment</li> <li>• College tuition changes year to year so staying connected is important <i>as the amount of money students can get varies.</i></li> <li>• There are other grants and scholarships they can apply for to help with other college expenses</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Why is it important to stay updated on yearly changes in college?</li> <li>• What other financial aid options can help cover college expenses besides the CB funds?</li> <li>• Bonus activity: Check the maximum award amounts for CB at <a href="http://wsac.wa.gov/college-bound#using-college-bound">wsac.wa.gov/college-bound#using-college-bound</a></li> </ul>

<p>After watching chapter 4, students will know...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The benefits of college or career training after high school</li><li>• That CB can help with many types of educational pathways</li><li>• CB supports a vast number of career paths</li><li>• CB funding is flexible and can be used at public and private 4-year universities, 2-year community colleges, and many career training programs in WA state.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What are the benefits of pursuing postsecondary education with the help of CB?</li><li>• How can CB support different educational and career pathways?</li><li>• What types of schools can you use CB at?</li></ul>

## Chapter 5: Where can I get help? What is OtterBot?
