WSU Notes:

In Pullman only, additional fees include Student Recreation Center, Health, Transit, and CUB fee which total \$795 for all groups. Resident and nonresident undergraduates also pay an additional \$50 for the stadium for a total of \$845. **In Spokane only**, the mandatory health fee is \$151.

Students in the **legacy MBA program in Pullman** continue to pay the regular graduate student tuition rate.

Students **continually enrolled in the Masters of Nursing program** since 2004-05 academic year pay a lower transitional rate as they complete their programs.

In 2008-09 these amounts increase to \$9,728 and \$22,150 respectively.

WWAMI. Under a memorandum of understanding (MOU) between WSU and UW, students attending the first year of medical school in Seattle, Pullman or Spokane will pay the same total amount of the special UW enrollment fee and tuition. For students attending Pullman or Spokane, the tuition amount will be reduced by the \$150 per year enrollment fee paid directly to the University of Washington School of Medicine by the student. Other mandatory fees will be assessed based on the specific campus the student attends and benefits from. Program specific fees, such as the immunization fee, will be assessed as documented in the MOU.

General & Institution Specific Notes:

Tuition and fee rates reflect those reported by institutions.

Services and Activities Fee: S&A fees can increase by a percentage not to exceed the annual percent increase in respective tuition category; this increased rate did not apply to the amount committed to repayment of bonded debt.

TESC additional mandatory fees for 2008-09 include health & counseling fees, a bus pass fee, clean energy fee, CAB building fee and WASH-PIRG contribution. The fees are standard across all categories and total \$532 per year.

WWU additional mandatory fees include a health service fee, non-academic building fee, renewable energy fee levied on a per credit basis to a maximum of 10 credit hours per quarter, a student recreation fee and a transportation fee. These fees are standard across all categories and total \$696 per year.

Community college tuition and fee rates are based on 15 credit hours per quarter. The tuition figure above reflects the maximum S&A fee. Other fees, including technology fees vary by school.
