WA Grant isn't only for traditional college students. WA Grant for Apprenticeship (WG-A) includes funding for qualified apprentices in a variety of programs in Washington. Eligible apprentices can receive money to cover costs associated with their apprenticeship program.

Recruit and support your apprentices with WA Grant for Apprenticeship

Participating sponsors must:

1. Offer a Washington State L&I registered apprenticeship program.
2. Apply to participate in WG-A.
3. Follow WSAC program administration requirements.



WA Grant is for more types of education

WA Grant can pay for many kinds of learning, including:

- Approved apprenticeship programs.
- Workforce and training programs.

And gives more money...

An apprentice from a family of four making up to \$139,500 can qualify. Funding provides:

- Money for tuition, fees, books, and necessary equipment.
- Additional money on top of regular pay that doesn't need to be paid back.

- Eligible apprentices of all ages.
- Part-time and full-time participants.
