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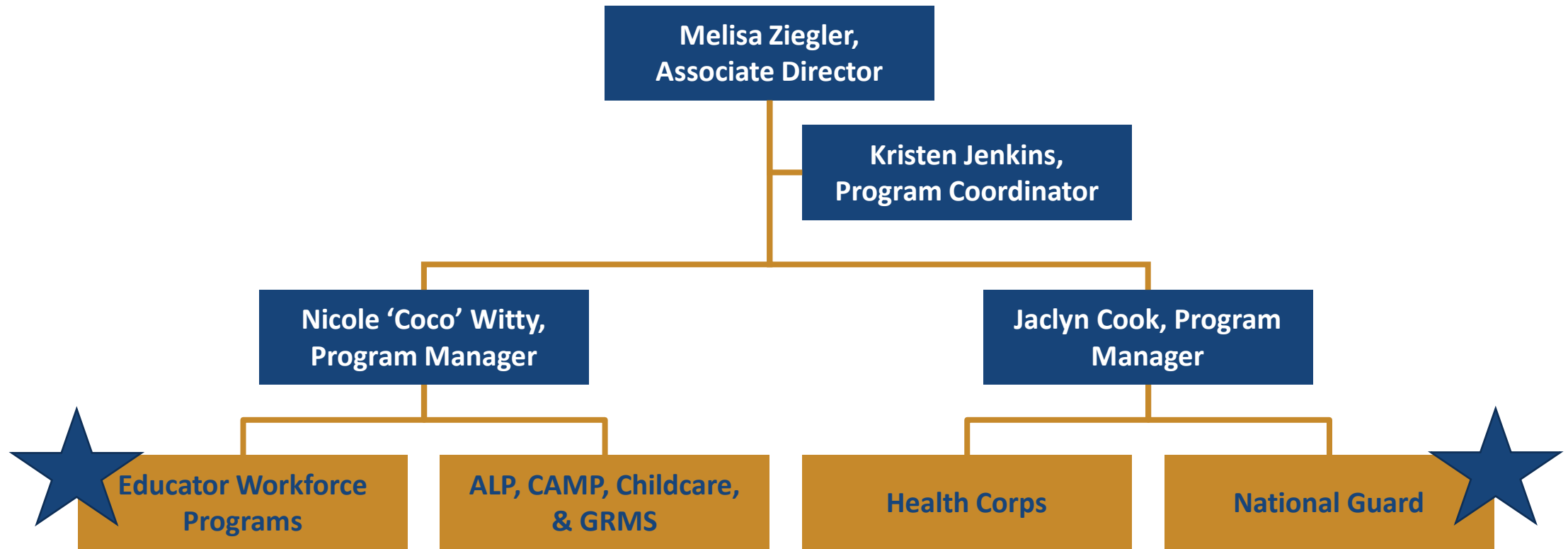

NGG: Award Calculation

Factors that Impact Award Amount

1. Type of Institution

2. Level of Enrollment

3. Total Aid

4. Expected Family Contribution (if receiving need-based aid)

5. \$500 Stipend for Books and Materials



NGG: Examples and Allowable Uses of Award Funds

Award Factors	Student Receiving Some Need-Based Aid	Student Receiving No Need-Based Aid
Tuition and Fees COA: (Institution Type and WCG Max)	Public CTC 2-Year \$4,219	Independent/Private 4-Year \$11,040
Quarters Enrolled:	FT 3 quarters	FT 3 quarters
Total Aid:	\$5,300 (Federal and State Aid)	\$0
EFC:	\$0	\$85,353
Award Calculation:	Tuition & Fees COA – Total Aid = \$0 + Books/Materials (\$500) =	Tuition & Fees COA – Total Aid + Books/Materials (\$500) =
Total Award:	\$500	\$11,540



NGG: Military Benefits and Award Calculation

- Follow the guidance provided in:
 - 2019-2020 FSA Handbook Volume 3 and Appendix A
 - “Guidance on Federal Veterans’ Education Benefits for Purposes of the Title IV Student Assistance Programs”
- Examples of funds to **not include** in federal aid for NGG:
 - Chapter 1606
 - GoArmy
 - Post 9-11 GI Bill



Changes to Enrollment and Repayment Policy

- Quarterly verification to check on enrollment from certification
- Changes to enrollment are likely to mean changes to the award amount
- Time of withdrawal is important
 - If student attended class(es) then withdrew, can keep award at original award level.
 - If student did not attend class(es) and withdrew prior to start, funds will need to be returned based on updated award amount.
- Conditional scholarship converts to loan if service not fulfilled
- WSAC tracks eligibility

EWP: Award Calculation for STG and TSCS

Factors that Impact Award Amount

1. Cost of Attendance

2. Expected Family Contribution

3. Total Aid

4. Terms Enrolled



EWP: Examples and Allowable Uses of Award Funds

Award Factors	Student Receiving Large Need-Based Aid	Student Receiving Small Need-Based Aid
Cost of Attendance:	\$22,620	\$22,620
EFC:	\$0	\$0
Total Aid:	\$19,539	\$4,675
Quarters Enrolled:	FT 3 quarters	FT 2 quarters*
Award Calculation:	COA – EFC – Total Aid = \$3,081	COA – EFC – Total Aid = \$17,945 Max award = \$8,000 *eligible for 2/3 of max award
Total Award:	\$3,081	\$5,333



Changes to Enrollment and Repayment Policy

- Quarterly verification to check on enrollment from certification
- Changes to enrollment may not mean changes to the award amount
- Time of withdrawal is important
 - If student attended class(es) then withdrew, can keep award at original award level.
 - If student did not attend class(es) and withdrew prior to start, funds will need to be returned based on updated award amount.
- Conditional scholarship converts to loan if service not fulfilled
